'You Are A Square' (Glyph Activity)

Use paper pattern block shapes to represent your family members.

You are the square. If you are a girl, add one blue rhombus to the square. If you are a boy, add one tan rhombus to the square. Represent each adult with a yellow hexagon. Represent each of your siblings with a trapezoid and each pet with a triangle. Use all of the shapes to create a polygon, making sure that your blocks are connected along matching sides. Glue the polygon to a sheet of paper. Use the back of your paper to write additional family details. Share your creation with a classmate. (based on Teaching Children Mathematics, August 2008, p. 33)
