OBJECTIVE: Be the first player to complete your layout of the multiples from least to greatest.

DIRECTIONS:

- 1. Each player lays 10 cards face down into two rows of five cards each. The remaining cards are face down in the middle to form the draw pile.
- 2. The first player draws one card. The player must determine where the card goes in the sequence. Example: If playing the 2's facts and you draw a 10, the player will count 2, 4, 6, 8, 10 and place the card in the 5th spot.
- 3. Now the player takes the card in the 5th spot and will decide where the card goes. The first player continues to place cards until they get a duplicate. The duplicate goes in the garbage pile and their turn is over.
